Exam Fee	AP (Advanced Placement) Exam	\$100 per exam (Fee cost based on College Board Fee)	To cover cost of the AP exam	Student cannot sit for exam
Exam Fee	AP (Advanced Placement) Late Exam Fee	\$60 per exam (Fee cost based on College Board Fee)	To cover a portion of the cost to administer a College Board (\$15) late exam and the actual cost charged by College Board for an approved late AP exam (\$45)	Student will not be able to take the exam on an alternate date
Exam Fee	AP (Advanced Placement) Late Ordering Fee	\$55 per exam (Fee cost based on College Board Fee)	To cover the cost of ordering an AP exam after the College Board designated ordering deadline	Student will not be able to take the exam/s
Exam Fee	AP (Advanced Placement) Unused Exam Fee	\$40 per exam (based on College Board Fee)	To cover the cost of returning an unused AP exam to College Board	Exam was ordered per student request but student did not take exam
Exam Fee	PSAT Exam	\$20 per year	To cover a portion of the cost of PSAT exam	Student cannot sit for exam

Course Fee	D20 On-line School course fee	\$250 per overload course	Fee applies only to D20 students who are choosing to take an overload through the on-line program. Purpose is to cover a portion of the cost associated with an overloaded course schedule	Student cannot take an on-line overload course
Course Fee	Field Trip Fee	Varies by field trip – See field trip sponsor	To cover cost or a portion of the cost of admission, activity, and transportation. Check with trip sponsor for specific fee	A comparable alternative may be provided. A student who desires to participate in class field trip will not be excluded if the fee is unpaid
Parking	Student Parking Pass	\$20 per semester	To cover a portion of the cost of parking lot maintenance	Student cannot park vehicle in school parking lots during school hours
User Fee	District issued personal mobile technology device	\$50 per school year	To offset a portion of the cost of devices, to protect against initial accidental damage/loss, and to offset the cost of repair	Student will not be issued a personal mobile technology device

Beginning in 2015-16, a student fee schedule specific to each school shall be posted to the school website in a prescribed location and shall be updated annually.
